Eligibility Criteria for Institute Quota Candidates

- Candidate should be an Indian National.
- In order to secure admission to first year of four year degree courses in Engineering, the candidates should fulfill the following eligibility criteria;

I) Educational Qualification: Passed the HSC (Std. XII) examination of Maharashtra State Board of Secondary and Higher Secondary Education or its equivalent examination with:

- Ø Physics
- Ø Chemistry
- Ø Mathematics and
- Ø English as one of the subjects **AND**

- Secured minimum 50% marks in PCM (Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics added together.)

II) Entrance Test Requirement:-

MHT-CET-2010 Candidates

1. Educational qualification as specified in rule number I.
2. Appeared for the Maharashtra –Health Technical –Common Entrance Test (MHT-CET-2010) conducted by the Government of Maharashtra for the academic year 2010-11 and secured non-zero score.

III) Admission to BIOMEDICAL ENGINEERING COURSE:

Candidates seeking admission to Biomedical Engineering course should have passed in the subject of **Biology** in the qualifying examination in addition to the Eligibility Criteria as mentioned in Rule No. I.

IV) NOTE:

1. In case the maximum marks in individual subject is other than 100 or total marks other than 300,

then while converting marks out-of-100 or total out-of-300, no rounding off of the marks will be done. If the converted mark works out to be a figure with fraction, fraction up to two decimal places will only be considered. E.g. if marks obtained (after conversion) added together work out to be 149.99 out of 300 then such a candidate will not be eligible for seeking admission to Degree courses in Engineering.

2. If letter grades are assigned instead of marks at SSC, HSC or its equivalent examination the candidate must obtain the certificate of conversion of letter of grades into marks from the competent authority where from the candidate has passed the examination. The candidate should produce such certificate at the time of submission of application form.

Eligibility Criteria for Sindhi Quota Candidates

- Candidate should be an Indian National.
 - In order to secure admission to first year of four year degree courses in Engineering, the candidates should fulfill the following eligibility criteria;
- I) **Educational Qualification:** Passed the HSC (Std. XII) examination of Maharashtra State Board of Secondary and Higher Secondary Education or its equivalent examination with:
- Ø Physics
 - Ø Chemistry
 - Ø Mathematics and
 - Ø English as one of the subjects **AND**
- Secured minimum 50% marks in PCM (Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics added together.)
- II) **Entrance Test Requirement:**
1. Sindhi Candidates who are domicile in the state of Maharashtra.
 2. Educational qualification as specified in rule number I .
 3. Appeared for the Maharashtra – Health Technical – Common Entrance Test (MHT-CET- 2010) conducted by the Government of Maharashtra for the academic year 2010-11 and secured non-zero score.
- III) **Admission to BIOMEDICAL ENGINEERING COURSE:**
Candidates seeking admission to Biomedical Engineering course should have passed in subject of **Biology** in the qualifying examination in addition to the Eligibility Criteria as mentioned in Rule No. I
- IV) **NOTE:**
1. In case the maximum marks in individual subject is other than 100 or total marks other than 300, then while converting marks out-of-100 or total out-of-300, no rounding off of the marks will be done. If the converted mark works out to be a figure with fraction, fraction up to two decimal

places will only be considered.

2. If letter grades are assigned instead of marks at SSC, HSC or its equivalent examination the candidate must obtain the certificate of conversion of letter of grades into marks from the competent authority where from the candidate has passed the examination. The candidate should produce such certificate at the time of submission of application form.

Assignment of Merit Number

I Merit Number: (INSTITUTE QUOTA)

Each Institute Quota candidate who has submitted application form on or before the last date prescribed for the submission of the application form will be assigned a Merit Number based on the marks in MHT-CET-2010.

Assignment of a Merit number does not indicate or ensure admission to any seat.

II A Merit List shall be prepared on the basis of MHT-CET-2010 Score.
Assignment of a Merit number does not indicate or ensure admission to any seat.

Merit Number: (SINDHI QUOTA)

Each Sindhi Quota candidate from Maharashtra State who has submitted application form on or before the last date prescribed for the submission of the application form will be assigned a Merit Number based on the MHT-CET-2010 score.
